Speaker Biographies

Professor Peter Roberts - Professor Emeritus at the University of Leeds and Co-Chair of the NHS Confederation Sustainable Development Group



Professor Peter Roberts is involved in a range of regional and urban planning, regeneration, housing and health, economic development and environmental management activities.

Peter has developed an extensive portfolio of business and governance activities. His knowledge of business processes is wide ranging, as is his familiarity with governance and corporate social responsibility agendas. He has been involved in the environmental, economic and social regeneration of disadvantaged communities in Greater London, Yorkshire, Merseyside and elsewhere and most recently much of his work has focussed on the

impact of climate change and mitigation strategies.

His research and practice interests have caused him to be involved in several expert committee and task forces, including the roles of Chair of the Byker Task Force, Chair of the Oldham Beyond Initiative and the Chair of the Kirklees Climate Commission.

He has been active for many years in academic and professional organisations and has published widely across his fields of interests.
